Railing Closures

On existing posts

Installing the closure



Before installing each Rail, measure the dimension between the posts and then cut the railing closure according to this dimension, less 20mm.



Position one of the supports of the bottom part on the post. Mark the drill holes. Drill, then secure with pins (not provided). Attach the support of the bottom part to the post (screws not provided).



Using the Rail, position the support of the opposite bottom part so that it is level with the other support. Draw a marker.



Mark the drill holes. Drill, then secure with pins (not provided). Attach the 2nd support of the bottom part to the post (screws not provided).



Insert the Rail in the supports of the bottom part.



Insert the 2 supports of the top part onto the Rail.
If necessary, use a plastic mallet to ensure the holes are aligned.



Attach the Rail using the hollow hex screws M5x8, until pressurized. These screws enable the support to be locked in place.



Repeat this process for each Rail to be installed.
